ETHN 173GS: Gender, Sexuality, and War

Program Highlights:

- Examines the impact of the American war in Vietnam on three populations: Americans, Vietnamese, and the Viet Kieu (the post-1975 population of overseas Vietnamese)
- Explore the gendered dimensions of armed conflict, sexual violence, and militarization
- Visit the South Vietnam Women Museum and the War Remnants Museum.

What are Global Seminars?

UCSD Global Seminars are 5 week long, summer study abroad experiences led by a UCSD professor. Students enroll in 2 English-taught courses (8 UCSD quarter units) and class sizes are between 15–28 students. Global Seminars provide a unique way to earn credit for your major, minor, GEs, or college requirements, all while exploring a new country and culture.
